

**Georgia Department of Transportation and the City of Douglasville
To Hold
A Location and Design Public Information Open House
for Project STP00-0186-01(011), CSSTP-0006-00(900)(901) and CSSTP-0007-00(691)
Douglas and Paulding Counties

On Tuesday, October 27th, 2009 at Stewart Middle School located at 8138 Malone Street, Douglasville, Georgia, the Georgia Department of Transportation and the City of Douglasville will hold a Public Information Open House concerning Projects STP00-0186-01(011), CSSTP-0006-00(900)(901) and CSSTP-0007-00(691), Douglas and Paulding Counties.

Projects STP00-0186-01(011), CSSTP-0006-00(900)(901) and CSSTP-0007-00(691), in Douglas and Paulding Counties is a proposal to widen and realign State Route (SR) 92/Fairburn Road and SR 92/Dallas Highway from just south of Durelee Lane in Douglas County to Nebo Road in Paulding County and the construction of three grade-separated structures at the proposed SR 92 intersections with US 78/Bankhead Highway, the Norfolk Southern Railroad and East Strickland Street. The proposed project would also include the relocation and upgrade of the existing at-grade railroad crossing at McCarley Street and the closing of three existing at-grade crossing in Downtown Douglasville; SR 92/Dallas Highway, Mozley Street and Brown Street.

The purpose of this Open House is to provide the public with an opportunity to view the proposed project, ask questions, and comment on the proposal. The purpose is also to show the proposed project revisions between Durelee Lane and Malone Road and the proposed mitigation plan.

The Open House will be conducted between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. The Open House will be informal and the public is invited to attend anytime during these hours. There will be no formal presentation.
